

Applications will not be accepted and permits will not be granted without applicant's signature below.

Drainage, water and sewer must be protected by contractor.
City standards must be met, or upgraded if required.
Revegetation or erosion control may be required.
Work must be inspected by the Public Works Director or his designee.

Any construction activity which obstruct--even temporarily--any portion of sidewalk streets, curb and gutters within Idaho Springs must be approved.

(§19-33) When any portion of a street or sidewalk is to be blocked, proper barricades must be installed and a safe passageway provided. This may include construction of a covered walkway to maintain safe pedestrian access. Contractor must provide traffic control.

A performance bond posted by the contractor or landowner may be required by the City for certain construction, or paving projects either within or directly affecting public right of way.

(§19-32) Replacement curb, gutter, sidewalk backfill must be done to City standards. "Work site must meet OSHA standards. Work must be inspected by Public Works Director or Designee.

City's working hours are 6 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Prior arrangements must be made (24 hours) for inspections. Off hours or weekend inspections will be subject to overtime payment by contractor/landowner.

Contractor or Landowner may be required to pay for full-time inspection. Depending on location, excavation may not be allowed to remain open overnight. The City cannot provide manpower.

(§19-30) Curb and asphalt cuts must be approved by the Public Works Director or his Designee.

Major excavation for utility service repair or upgrade requires six months' prior notification to the City, emergencies excepted.

Locates require 24 hours' prior notice, emergencies excepted.

Lack of planning does not constitute an emergency.

The City assumes no responsibility in locates . Dig at your own risk.

Cold patch will be accepted for temporary repair. Ground temperature must be 40oF before any paving. State Highway C or Cx is required for long-term paving.

Upon receipt of application, it will be reviewed by Public Works, then list of requirements will be provided along with permit. Any problems or disagreements may be brought before Council.
